Jack of Hearts

Enduring through Devotion

Characteristics: The Jack of Hearts has a powerful vision of love and is a fixed Card along with two others. There is a spirit of Christ and sacrifice through love that surrounds them. Because of the influence and wisdom of the Christ spirit they have higher guidance and higher motives generally, in spite of being Jacks. As we know, sometimes Jacks are immature and sneaky, but the Jack of Hearts has characteristics that mitigate against this. They must be careful, however, not to acquire a martyr complex, which can happen if this gets out of control. It is possible for them to seek escape and be misguided, but this is not all that common. They have come to share their love and to guide us on their way by their example, because love is their strength and birthright. After they recognize that they have a mission of



love, they do accept the responsibility, because they know how to love with the good heart of a King. Their personal dreams may be given up for a higher vision or viewpoint and they frequently make sacrifices in their lives. They are usually successful in their own field and are born leaders. These individuals are focused and lead by a strong sense of fairness and duty. Unless they fall to the lower side of the sneaky Jack, they are dependable and follow through on promises. Bringing higher energy to their occupation and lives in general is where they are fulfilled and this is on a spiritual path. All those they associate with are to some degree uplifted by their presence, because this card carries the spirit of Christ within them.

Relationships: Jack characteristics are there even though the Jack of Hearts is a spiritual card. The young, playful, playboy or playgirl characteristics of this card can trap them too. Being the most romantic card in the deck, they too can be

lead into affairs and romantic liaisons. Depending on the individual, the sacrificial character of this card can work for or against them in relationships. A degree of immaturity may prove to be their downfall at times in their life, but these persons have the power and are strong enough, in their love character, to deal with it with resolve. They have their own philosophy of love that is immutable and usually they are devoted to higher ideals. You may be involved in their plan to save the universe and they sacrifice for you if they love you. By the same token, the Jack of Hearts can employ their savior mentality to do odd things in love such as selecting a partner that is totally unworthy or damaged so that they can use their love to heal someone. Bad consequences can result with this victim and savior situation or, in addition, there can be co-dependent relationships as a result. They begin to understand the pain love can result in and start to be an understanding and loving partner after a few losses in love. They are most highly devoted and loyal companions of the cards when they seek their higher purpose, which many of them do. They are prepared to make sacrifices for their loved ones if they need to and they are paragons of love that is profound and immovable.

Personality Connections: For the woman Jack of Hearts, Diamond men are generally not a good choice for love or marriage. Jack of Hearts usually prove a great difficulty for Club females. Other Heart men are good, however. The King and Eight have strong pulls because of karmic bonds. Sometimes though, it is too powerful.

Confrontations: Jesus Christ, the savior and messiah of in the Age of Pisces, is often mentioned in association with the Jack of Hearts. The Age of Pisces, however, is now concluding. In terms of the ordinary human experience he was a teacher who exemplified transcending love or agape. Venus in Pisces is a profound symbol of his love through sacrifice of the highest kind. Depending on what use it is put to, such a Neptunian quality can do wonderful good or terrible bad. At this point, some consider such sacrifice to be co-dependent and even an addiction. This is because, perhaps, we are entering the Age of Aquarius. Sadly, in the name of helping others, we have seen endless cases of people and groups misusing their spiritual power and, indeed, other powers as well. What Pisces teaches us does not matter and is useless in Aquarius. Exhaustion from giving so much afflicts many Jack of Hearts individuals. They become empty and spent unless they give something to themselves. If this happens, they are less able to give because there is less of themselves to do it.
